

Comprehensive Psychological Evaluations conducted by a Clinical Psychologist ~

The value of a comprehensive evaluation is that many different diagnosis and clusters of symptoms can be sorted out. Such symptoms might range from major depression to schizophrenia in adulthood. Symptom profiles often observed in youth include impulsivity; conduct disorder behavior, chemical abuse, as well as major depression and bipolar disorder.

It is often very difficult to get an accurate diagnosis without the aid of a comprehensive psychological evaluation. As a clinical psychologist, Dr. Peterson can provide not only the skills of clinical interviewing and the review of medical records, but also the advanced skill of providing projective (i.e., Rorschach & TAT) and objective psychological testing (MMPI- A/2 & MCMI-III).
